

Mr. Niemeyer works at the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) as the Border Affairs Manager, responsible for the TCEQ's U.S.-Mexico border programs. issues since June 1992. He is responsible for a number of U.S.-Mexico border activities at the TCEQ. These include: managing border air, water and waste technical studies; plan and specification reviews of water and wastewater systems; reviewing border waste and water and air quality studies and data; recommending policy for agency management on border issues; and development of TCEQ strategic border plans. He is currently responsible for implementing the agency's Border Initiative with Mexico.

He has represented the agency in various fora, including the binational Border XXI and Border 2012 programs; the Environment Table of the Border Governors Conference; as the TCEQ *colonias* liaison to the Texas Secretary of State; and NAFTA-related environmental entities the Border Environment Cooperation Commission, the North American Development Bank, and the Commission for Environmental Cooperation.

Since 2006 Mr. Niemeyer has served as the representative of the State of Texas on the Good Neighbor Environmental Board, a federal advisory committee to the President and the Congress on U.S.-Mexico border environmental issues. He is also a member of the Boundary International Water Quality Standards Committee of the American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE), and is a member of both ASCE and the National Society of Professional Engineers.

Prior to employment with the TCEQ, Mr. Niemeyer worked five years in environmental management and occupational safety and health in the private and non-profit sectors. He holds a B.S. in Chemistry from the University of Texas at San Antonio (1984) and a Master of Public Affairs degree from the Lyndon B. Johnson School of Public Affairs, University of Texas (1992). He is licensed in Texas as a Professional Engineer.

His current service work includes volunteer work for the Worker's Defense Project. He is also a member of the Texas Exes Advisory Council.
