### Biographical data for Tomas M. Rodriguez, Jr., P.E.

Tomas Rodriguez is the Director of Utilities for the City of Laredo. His career spans 46 years of private and public service in variety of areas, with 30 of those directly in the municipal water and wastewater field. Mr. Rodriguez is on his second tour with the City of Laredo, where he has served as Director from 1991 to 1996 and from 2007 to the present.

Mr. Rodriguez's other governmental experience includes working as Webb County Engineer in charge of the Water Utilities and Road and Bridge Departments, and as General Manager for the Del Mar Conservation Utility District, both in Laredo, Texas.

On the private sector Mr. Rodriguez managed Rodriguez Pipe and Steel and a variety of family-owned businesses, and worked as a consultant for Mejia Engineering Company. On his personal time, he has directed the construction of several Parishes in Laredo.

Mr. Rodriguez graduated a Civil Engineer from Texas A&M University in 1964 and served with distinction in the Marine Corps in Vietnam, where he was a Combat Engineer and Platoon Commander.
